On Saturday, December 10th, riders met at Little Feather Ranch for a day of riding fun. Another day is scheduled for January 21st.

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

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Election of Officers

From the By-Laws:

The officers of the Club shall be elected from and by the membership and shall consist of President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. Voting will be by paid members only so you will need to fill out the application form (all new and renewing members must fill out form) and sign the hold harmless agreement. The two forms are in this newsletter and also on the website. Please fill out the forms and bring with your dues to the January Meeting. (Dues are \$30 for Single and \$40 for family membership.)

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RIP Go Boy's Windwalker


On December 19th, Nya sent us the following email:

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
